WildEarth Guardians and other environmental groups collectively won a case
in 2005 to protect the silvery minnow habitat in the Rio Grande River. The
settlement agreement required payment of \$225,000 from the Albuquerque
Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority and \$25,000 from the
environmental groups, collectively, to be put into an escrow account. The
escrow agreement was for the period of January 18, 2007-2012. The funds
held in escrow are to be used to purchase water rights. If the funds
aren't used, they may be returned to the contributing parties. The parties
are negotiating an extension of the agreement. The Organization is the
fiscal agent of the funds. Cash and cash equivalents - fiscal agent cash
includes the escrow funds of \$270,093 at December 31, 2011.

Part V, Line 4 - Intended Uses for Endowment Funds

Board-designated Endowment: Board reserve for contingencies.

Permanent Endowment: The principal amount of the fund is to be held in perpetuity for the benefit of WildEarth Guardians with annual distributions of investment income to the organization.

Term Endowment: Amounts are spent in accordance with donors' designations.
