This letter refers to the air quality permit application, dated October 24, 2019 and received by the Air Quality Bureau on October 29, 2019, regarding draft Air Quality Permit No. PSD-8245 for the proposed Husky Gas Plant and Central Delivery Point facility that was submitted by XTO Energy Inc.

The New Mexico Environment Department Air Quality Bureau (AQB) received your comment letter dated January 16, 2020 expressing concern about XTO Energy Inc's application for an air quality permit to construct the proposed Husky Gas Plant and Central Delivery Point in Eddy County.
