Narrative 1 - ORIGINAL

On January 6th, 2019 I was dispatched to #534 Horton Road Edgewood, NM 87015 at 10:04am in reference to an injured dog. Santa Fe County Deputy C. Cullison advised me that an individual named Joe Pacheco had caught a dog in a foot trap off of his property.

Upon my arrival at 11:01am, contact was made with Deputy Cullison and Joe Pacheco. Joe advised that this dog had been causing problems for a while and had been going onto his property. Joe had set the foot trap up for Coyotes that has been giving him problems. I removed the tan and white Malamute type dog from the trap and loaded the dog into my animal service vehicle, where I then scanned for a microchip. I was unable to locate a microchip with my scanner and the dog did not have a collar or ID tags. Due to the back right foot of the dog having been injured by the foot trap it was transported and impounded at the Santa Fe Animal Shelter to be examined by the licensed veterinarians that are employed there.

The Santa Fe Animal Shelter staff was able to located a microchip but at this time were unable to contact an owner.
